Record information into FoxScan to help protect farmers and biodiversity.

FoxScan is a free community resource for monitoring, mapping and managing foxes. People are using FoxScan to record fox activity and coordinate local control programs. It can be used by landholders, community groups, local government, pest controllers and biosecurity organisations. The FeralScan App is available to download free-of-charge from the AppStore and Google play store. It can be used by anyone to record information about foxes anywhere, including areas <u>without</u> mobile reception. You can record sightings and evidence of foxes, attacks, and control actions. 
How to record fox sightings or activity



How to view data from your entire group

If you are part of a Private Group using FeralScan, you can view all the records from members of the Group on the map. Follow the steps below.



- 1. Open the website, and Login
- 2. Open the Map
- 3. Click on 'Select Data'
- 4. Select your group name, and 'View on Map'
