

# Record information into ToadScan to help protect farmers and biodiversity.


ToadScan is a free community resource for monitoring, mapping and managing cane toads. People are using ToadScan to record toad activity and coordinate local control programs. It can be used by landholders, community groups, local government, pest controllers and biosecurity organisations. ### How to use the Mobile App

The FeralScan App is available to download free-of-charge from the AppStore and Google play store. It can be used by anyone to record information about toads anywhere, including areas without mobile reception. You can record sightings and evidence of cane toads, damage, and control actions. 1. Select toad




From the app home screen select the toad image.



- 1. Open the website, and Login
- 2. Open the Map
- 3. Click on 'Select Data'
- 4. Select your group name, and 'View on Map'
